CAR PARKING



HOW TO REACH THE CRICKET GROUND BY PUBLIC TRANSPORT

For those using public transport and arriving in Leicester by train, the map below shows details of the relevant bus services - please use the number 84 or 85 and exit the bus on Aylestone Road near Aldi. Then walk up to Park Drive where stewards from Leicestershire County Cricket Club will open the gates for your easy access to the Pavilion. These gates will also be open for you to use after the event.
