ACS MEMBERSHIP BULLETIN

No. 64 – 21 February 2026

The twelfth General Committee meeting of 2025/26 took place on Saturday 17 January 2026 on a virtual basis. The Committee discussed progress with the February mailing, which included the Journal and the AGM booklet. The discussion took account of the challenges that had occurred since we had been advised just before Christmas that City Press, which has provided printing, typesetting and other services to ACS for some years, had decided not to reopen again after Christmas. The committee discussed the action that had been taken to engage alternative suppliers and the longer-term implications. The committee noted that the steps taken in recent years to spread printing work among different firms had reduced the risk to ACS considerably on this occasion. The committee discussed the desirability of seeking volunteers to take over from Andrew Hignell as Association Secretary and agreed to advertise the vacancy as soon as possible. It also heard updates on the extensive work currently going on to post archive material on the ACS website (119 books, 11,220 pages of the Tony Webb Archive and 4,797 pages of the Bernard Wilkins Scrapbooks added since the previous committee meeting) and expressed thanks to those who had volunteered to help with this and other work. Plans for future members' meetings were discussed and will be announced in the coming months. Finally, the committee received an update on the Association's healthy financial position, which will be reported to the AGM in March.
